Crosswalk Update!

I'm happy to share that improvements are coming soon. My contact at MCDOT confirmed that additional signage will be installed THIS SUMMER! Specifically, there will be fluorescent yellow green pedestrian crossing signs with down arrows on both sides of the road, in both directions. Additionally, MCDOT will install reflective strips (also fluorescent yellow green) on all of the sign posts to add additional conspicuity.
